



**THE POWER OF FAITH**  
**Luke 5.17-26**

*This story about the paralytic being lowered down in front of Jesus is more about the faith of his four friends that it is about him. Notice what this event in the life of Jesus teaches us about faith:*

**I. \_\_\_\_\_ FAITH**

*We pray for that ONE person to be saved because it is our \_\_\_\_\_ that fuels our prayers. If we don't \_\_\_\_\_ God can save then we won't be praying for our friends to be saved*

**II. \_\_\_\_\_ FAITH**

*You and I must be \_\_\_\_\_ any obstacles that may be put in our way to keep us from praying or sharing the gospel with that ONE lost person.*

**III. \_\_\_\_\_ FAITH**

*As you pray for your ONE to come to faith in Christ, understand that you are praying \_\_\_\_\_ the power of the Holy Spirit and you are praying \_\_\_\_\_ the power of Holy Spirit to do what only God can do, and that is forgive them and save them*

IV. \_\_\_\_\_ FAITH

HEB. 11.6: *And without faith it is impossible to please him, for he who comes to God must believe that he is and that he is a rewarder of those who seek Him.*
